

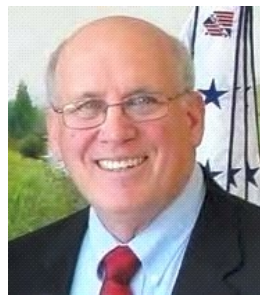

**President's Remarks**

With the indulgence of our members, I would like to share a bit of my personal history, at least that part which relates to the Department of Defense (DOD) commemoration of the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Vietnam War. Fifty years ago, 1966, I was newly married, had a child on the way, and was about to receive my ROTC commission from the University of Tennessee. A year later, I would be in Vietnam as a 2d lieutenant, United States Army. I was about to take the first steps in my life-long education about what it means to be an American soldier, a husband of an Army wife, and a father. It was truly the most important year in my young life.

Fifty years on, our Nation is thanking and honoring veterans of the that war for their sacrifice and service, paying tribute to Americans who served on the home front, POW's and MIA's, government agencies that supported the war effort and its warriors, and our allies. Based on a show of hands in our Chapter, we have more than a few members who served on active duty and spouses who served at home from November 1, 1955 to May 15, 1975, the official period of recognition.

Our program in November will be a tribute to those who wore the uniform during the conflict. Those who are present will receive a pin identifying them as a Vietnam Veteran, as is provided for by the commemoration agency of the DOD. Respectfully, Spence

The agenda centered around the top issues that each unit felt were the most pressing. The consistent theme was difficulty recruiting new cadets in an on-going competitive atmosphere with the school bands and HS athletic programs. In addition, many key activities rely on field trips, including community involvement/volunteering, and student transportation has been significantly impaired due to today's litigious-wary environment.

Despite these challenges, the managing officers and senior NCOs are excelling at teaching citizenship and leadership to these young adults, and the SMS's efforts to assist them has been a highlight of the Satellite's endeavors over the past several years. Our seat on the Volunteer Services Committee involves attending quarterly meetings, sharing needs, and encouraging participation as volunteers. Recently we have participated in the Asheville Stand Down for homeless vets by donating 99 tee shirts and 15 dozen pairs of socks and providing two volunteers, run a bingo game at the Community Living Center (CLC), donating magazines and various cracker packets. As one of three regularly active volunteers, I work in the Intensive Care waiting room five hours a week. The work of volunteers is greatly appreciated by the veterans, who need contact with friendly folks who can provide many things regular staff cannot. The Volunteer Program at our hospital is very well organized and the time volunteered is invaluable.

### Free Flu Vaccinations for VA healthcare system enrollees

The Department of Veterans Affairs has once again teamed up with Walgreens Pharmacies nationwide to allow all **veterans who are currently enrolled in the VA healthcare system** to be able walk into any of the over 8000 Walgreens nationally to receive a vaccination at no cost. Vaccinations will be available through March 31, 2017. Veterans must fill out a voucher, and present a Veterans ID card and a photo ID at any participating Walgreens to receive the vaccination.

### Reminder: Columbus NC Veterans Day Parade (11 Nov 2016)

Come join the MOAA crew march in the Veteran's Day parade in Columbus, NC. This will be the fourth year that we have participated in this event.
